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## Filling In the Blanks

The prompt is only as useful as what you put into it. A few notes on each line so you can answer with the kind of detail that gets you a real answer instead of a generic one.

<b>Blank</b>	<b>What to put there</b>
Climate	The actual range you live in across the year, not the average. Include rain, humidity, and temperature swings if they matter.
Lifestyle	A short list of where you spend your time — home, work, church, school pickup, travel, caregiving, exercise.
Energy type or style preferences	How you like clothes to feel on you. Soft, tailored, flexible, layered. Colors that show up when you feel best.



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What I already own	A rough summary, not a full inventory. Tops, bottoms, what colors dominate, what's been sitting unused.
What feels frustrating	The honest part. Where you keep getting stuck — too many options, nothing fits the weather, getting dressed takes too long.

## A Note on the Follow-Up

Good AI conversations are not one-and-done. After the first answer, push back. Ask why a piece was suggested. Tell it what you actually have. Tell it what feels wrong about the recommendation. The second and third rounds are where the useful answers live.
