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The Mix-and-Match Test

A capsule earns its name when most pieces work with most others. Pick five pieces from the list above and write down how many full outfits you can build from just those five.

Piece	Outfits it builds with the rest



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If the number is small, the gap isn't another piece, it's a piece that connects what you already have.
