## Review Pattern Analyzer Prompt

### Replacing hours of review-scrolling with one good question

Reading reviews is exhausting and often misleading. The loudest voices skew negative or positive, the middle of the distribution gets buried, and you end up with a vague impression rather than a clear pattern. This prompt does the work for you.

### The prompt

*I'm comparing these providers in [category]: [Provider A, Provider B, Provider C].*

*Pull together the patterns across their reviews. For each provider, give me:*

*• Their three most consistent strengths (what shows up across many reviews, not just one or two) • Their three most consistent weaknesses (same standard) • The kind of client they seem to serve best • The kind of client they seem to serve worst • Any red flags I should know about • Anything that surprises you about the pattern*

*Be honest. I'd rather hear something hard now than discover it after I've hired them.*

### A few small upgrades that make it sharper

**Add your context:** *"Our situation is [brief]. With that in mind, who looks like the best fit?"*

**Ask for the dissent:** *"What does the strongest critic of each provider say, even if it's a minority view?"*

**Ask for the gap:** *"What's a question I should be asking that the reviews don't answer?"*

### One small note

AI synthesis is a starting point, not a verdict. Use it to narrow your list and shape your interview questions, then trust your own conversations and instincts to make the call. The reviews tell you who they've been. The interview tells you who they are now.
